

# Peter Kofoeds R 38, "Christian" af Helligpeder, 1920

Peter Kofoed's *Christian*, R 38, of Helligpeder, 1920



**Halvdæksbåden "Christian" af Helligpeder, R 38, er bygget i Svaneke af bådebygger P. Hansen i 1920. Båden har haft flere forskellige ejere.**

**Den blev bygget til fiskerne Ludvig Olsen, Martin Lind og Karl Jensen i Gudhjem. Typisk bornholmsk, eg på eg med fyldige linier (deraf øgenavnet "Potten").**

*The half-decked Christian of Helligpeder, R-38, was built in Svaneke by boatbuilder P. Hansen in 1920. The boat has had several owners. It was built in Gudhjem for fishermen Ludvig Olsen, Martin Lind and Karl Jensen. Typical Bornholm building technique, oak on oak with a portly style (hence its nickname "The Pot").*

**26 fod og en bruttotonnage på godt 5 t. Firetakt "Hein"-motor på 8 hk.**

**"Christian" har hovedsagelig været anvendt til sildefiskeri, men også til fiskeri efter torsk og laks. Sidste ejer var Peter Kofoed, Helligpeder, der i 1984 overdrog "Christian" R38 til Bornholms Museum.**

*26 feet and a gross tonnage of more than five tonnes. A four-stroke 8 HP Hein motor. The Christian was primarily used for herring fishing, but also to fish for cod and salmon. Its last owner was Peter Kofoed, Helligpeder, who donated the Christian, R 38, to Bornholms Museum in 1984.*
